We are always striving to add more flavors to the signature lifestyle of DHA so lets join our efforts to raise the standard and promote happy and peaceful living in DHA.



Tree Plantation on different Boulevards, Family Park, JFC area and seasonal flowers at focal points in Phase II shall also be undertaken simultaneously.










MASJIDS





New Trends in Home Building

Things are changing around us in all dimensions. Depleting resources, high costs of energy, escalating living costs and changing weather conditions coupled with unpredictable environment is now compelling people to think differently and objectively to review their needs, demands and lifestyles.

Home... a basic psychological need has gone through many phases. Some of the most common emerging concepts can be summarized as under:

Smaller & Green Homes

In US the median size home fell from 2277 sq ft to 2135 sq ft. The overall shrinkage is between 10-15 percent. The benefits are obviously in saving on construction, energy and maintenance cost. The concept is to enhance the efficiency of lifestyle in serving you well by doing more in less space. Some of the other aspects of new home building are:

- Expanding size of Porch and incorporation of verandas.
- ▶ Creating feeling of openness with large & comfortable living by doing away with drawing rooms.
- ▶ Reducing sizes and number of bathrooms with incorporation of storage spaces.
- ▶ Single storey homes with cellars and attics for storage with insulated roofs.
- ▶ Large walk in closets and optimization of spaces by creating room mezzanine.
- ▶ Geothermal heating and cooling of well insulated homes.

Energy Efficient

Shrinking energy and escalating costs has compelled builders to go for energy efficient homes in terms of insulation, double-glazed windows, sealed ductwork, Energy Star appliances and use of LED Lights. Another dimension is the passive measures to maximize the use of incipient energy towards following:

- Well lit homes to avoid use of electrical lights during day time.
- ▶ Cross-ventilated homes for natural cooling.
- Use of rooftop solar geysers for water & room heating.

Safety & Security

There is growing trend in enforcing homes against building safety, natural calamities and man triggered disasters. Use of passive and active security devices e.g cameras, warning systems, motion detector and alarm system are now being embedded in the designs

Information System

Homes are now being built for value & efficiency. Practical and multiple use role are in place. Kitchens are being made a family place with areas devoted to charging laptops, mobile phones and wi-fi devices. Other aspects are line & wireless connectivity, ducting and spots for high speed internet, telephony and TV streaming. Central console for Home Management System (HMS) for easy management & control are also gaining popularity.

Electrical & Plumbing

Use of high quality wires & pipes is perhaps the most important aspect in a home to obviate short circuiting, energy losses & leakages which may cost dearly later in terms of retrofits and upgrades. Another aspect are the drains which must drain by gravity with optimum capacity to cater for heavy rainfalls where required.

In Pakistan we are faced with worst energy scenario and perhaps the concept of big houses has to be revisited for smarter homes to get the best in terms of parking, space utilization, costs and alternate energy sources with obvious emphasis on safety and security.

HEALTH LINES

Solar Energy In Pakistan

Pakistan is an energy deficient country. Its population is increasing day by day. An estimated over 170 million people inhabit Pakistan today. While the energy consumption is increasing with the passage of time, the production is stagnant. Presently Pakistan's production capacity is around 20,000 megawatts, out if which, 65 per cent is through fossil fuel, 33 per cent from hydro and 2 per cent from nuclear. Pakistan's current need is around 14,000 to 15,000 MW and even that is not being met. There is, thus, a shortfall of about 3000 to 4000MW.

Pakistan today suffers badly in its trade, business & household due to energy crises. The availability of diverse resources is there, it is only a question of will of government to formulate appropriate policies in this regard. Pakistan has vast coal deposits, however, it has been claimed that coal quality is inferior and having low BTU (British thermal unit).

Another alternative is hydel power. However, power produced by the turbines depends on quantity of water flowing/minute and the head of water available. As regards thermal power, the gas reserves are depleting and the oil prices are fluctuating sharply. With a coastline of about 1000 km, wind energy could be another option for Pakistan.

In this scenario, solar energy remains a viable option with numerous benefits. It is reliable and environmental friendly. Once installed, solar panels run for at least 20 years. Since these can be installed in a number of small localities. The solar energy resource in Pakistan has been estimated at 100,000 MW, as we are 6th luckiest country in the world where sun availability is up to 3000 hours on average in a year.

There is a continuous rise in the demand for energy as population is increasing Moreover, load shedding and top of that electricity price hikes. The installation of equipment to generate solar energy can be managed through international donors and resourceful countries like Germany, China to help develop local technology to bring down the production costs.

The technology used in solar energy is relatively simple. Solar panels basically utilize solar cells in their manufacture. There are two types of solar panels: multi-crystalline (polycrystalline) solar panels and mono-crystalline solar panels. The former contains many crystals. It has similar life span to the mono crystalline cell type, but it has lower efficiency and cost per watt. The latter is made of a single crystal. Such solar panels are highly efficient. In one panel, approximately 80 or more solar cells are used.

Government of Pakistan should consider these options to reduce energy crisis. Furthermore; our media should play a extensive role in awareness among the general masses.

Solar energy is very useful particularly at a time when we are concerned about greenhouse gas emissions from other energy sources. By taking the crucial steps to ensure that a billion people obtain electricity from the sun in the future, we can harness the full potential of solar power for our common good.

"GIS helps the real-estate industry analyze, report, map and model the merits of one site or location over another"

Once provided, home builders can assess the viability of these sites. They can subsequently modify the mix, size and nature of home construction to meet the business expectations of market or development goals.

In the light of above stated facts, mapping and area calculation aspects of GIS have been utilized in DHA Islamabad. DHA is digitizing masavies, geo reference and identification of the site location through survey as per the requirement. GIS also limits DHA boundaries by over laying of survey data on topographical sheets, masavies and even on high resolution satellite images. DHA Islamabad has already digitized and mapped most of its projects and being used for easy reference as per need of the hour. Analytical and planning aspects of GIS are in the pipe line.

HOW TO IMPROVE EFFICIENCY OF YOUR PC

We are living in an era of Information Technology, where there is hardly any sector left of our daily life where working does not depend on that peculiar pair of monitor and CPU which we have nick named as "system". If a system crashes, bank transactions are blocked, property transfers are pended, telephone lines go dead, buyers cannot reach sellers and no matter how important things are, everyone has to wait until the system recovers. At times, a wrong move with the computer hangs it and again the whole system halts. To be able to use computer, it is equally important to understand this device as well. Remove Temporary Files

Making a habit of removing Temporary Files from profile folder thereby decreasing the space consumption in C drive. While sending a request, computer usually generates a number of files in order to complete that request. Some files usually last till the completion of task and live out automatically. While some files remain in your cache and consume space untill they are manually deleted. These files create nuisance when these get activated and hinder other important processes. Therefore, it is crucial to clear out the temp folder periodically, more ideally, by the end of day.

Organize Desktop

Many of us have habit of storing things on desktop just to keep them in easy access, not thinking that desktop is also part of C drive and the processor has to make an extra effort to display them all the time. Everything in a computer is virtual, and your processor has to work for it just to make it visual for you. So, do not over populate your desktop.

Defragmentation

This process should ideally be done weekly, especially when your job requires loads of files to work on and you usually install number of softwares and programs or you get the message that the remaining space on your disk is less then 15%.

Through this method, files that are fragmented, are stored back in consolidated form and occupy single space on disk. With your files stored neatly end to end, it is easier and faster to access and use the disk space.

Spyware/Adware/Malware

Never install spyware or accept prompt messages that lead to installing malicious software on your computer. Spyware put your personal info at risk since these store information from the website you register yourself on and have to access through user name and passwords. The space these softwares take to process also hampers over all speed of computer. Rely on Windows' Tools for virus protection i.e. Microsoft Security Essentials or Microsoft Windows Malicious Software Removal Tool.

Remove and Repair Disk Errors

While using hard drive, it usually develops bad sectors which makes simple task like saving a file very difficult. It is important to pay heed to such occurance and ensure integrity of your files stored on your hard disk by running Error Checking Utility.




ROAD NETWORK






THE FIRST RAINDROP

On the morning of 2 March 2000, I started construction of my house in AWHS now known as DHA Phase-I. It was my privilege to be the first one to start construction. I was closely followed by Col Tanveer, Col Imtiaz and Col Najam. All of us were, as one can say, novices being non Engineer Officers, Our days were spent in visiting construction sites with a purpose to know how things have to proceed further and to realize our common problems.

A month prior to commencement of construction, I came with Director of AWHS, a colleague of mine who motivated me to start construction. He indicated me the electric poles and the water connections, but once we started construction, all of us realized that since it was project area of FWO the duration of electricity was only 4 hours a day and that too was unpredictable. The water pipes were present but one can reason out why employ labor, technicians etc for pumping, storing and distributing water for only one house. "But we have to start with One House before a colony comes up" was my usual remark.

It was my determination which enabled me to complete my house and I was the first one to move in on 14 March 2001 as they say lock stock and barrel. In those days there was only a small pole barrier of FWO near the Rabia Bungalows, The Fauji Foundation University / Medical College was obviously not there. As you entered the pole sign read "Allah Nighabaan". Since the barrier was only to check people from bringing out any item from the land beyond the barrier. Thus "Allah was our Nighabaan", once we crossed the barrier, wild growth, tall grass from 9 to 11 feet was everywhere. It was very common to come across wild boar, snakes and mongoose even at daytime around the bends. During the evening the area was infested with jackals. Since there was no litter there were no dogs.

The first night at about 10 PM the electricity went off, we were not prepared for the mosquitoes and thus when it became unbearable at about midnight we started the engine / AC of the car and slept till morning. My wife told our children "look your father has tried to give us a feel of his unit life and stay in Exercise Area, how we can live in this wilderness". However, things improved gradually. Our kitchen started functioning but the next day Col Tanveer with his wife came with a cake to celebrate our arrival in the new location. This tradition was maintained by all of us for the first ten to fifteen families subsequently it became unmanageable. The construction of houses increased exponentially and the Army Welfare Housing Scheme gradually bloomed and converted into Defence Housing Authority.

The present day DHA now has a proper staff to assist in the construction in the form of Engineering Directorate, Street Lights and Mobile Security patrols comb the area day and night. PTCL telephone and Teleman TV cable crisscross the whole area. One need not go to Saddar, Jungle Restaurant has lot of stuff to offer. Defence Mall and Masjid look after the social and spiritual aspects. New societies and housing projects starting coming up in all areas, but the way our DHA has come up, has only been possible because of the foresight, planning and execution by the management of DHA.

Despite all these improvements I still miss the sign at the entrance "Allah Nighabaan" and the wild life that one used to come across.

life after life A RESIDENT'S DIARY

While running on the parade ground I suddenly got pain in my chest. I tried to brush it aside. To me complain of pain in the presence of men and that too when in competition was something not acceptable. The pain persisted and I drove to the office. Now it was really painful. I was not in myself and was somewhat out of sorts. I wanted to shout but men lined up outside saluted. I firmly replied back and tried not fall before the men. Inside the room I sat on the chair but the pain was sharper and massive. I lay down. "the damn gastric trouble", I thought. But how come it is driving me mad. The clerk came in with the mail and I told him to wait. I again sat on the chair and asked orderly to call some officer. The message was SOS, that I was unwell which the orderly also read on my face. Two officers came running. By now I was lying on the ground and disoriented. Lucky for me that one of the officer was a heart patient who immediately guessed that it was a heart attack and the other got the car and I was rushed to AFIC. I asked Allah to 'save me' and tried to sit up and told the officers that I was feeling better, only to be taken over by pain again. It was terrible and I was losing my senses. I reached AFIC. Suddenly I realized that the time of death had come. I shouted "what the hell", "why me Allah". Some people were shouting and telling me to stay calm. What a lousy way to die in bed I thought. Again I shouted, "not in the bed! in the battle field". I meant it sincerely and desperately. Later on I was told that at one stage the E.C.G showed my heart in extremely unstable condition with the possibility of heart failure, probably due to blockage of an artery by a clot and StreptoKinase(SK), a drug still under trial then was used on me for the first time in AFIC.

After the phase of bewilderment, strangely enough, I was again relaxed, composed and prepared to die. My wife was at my bed side and my elder son sitting next to her. All in a state of shock, I told them not to worry "you will get a house from Housing Directorate. You could also -----"No" she shouted. I told my courageous little son, "Ali, look after your mother and uncle will look after you". He was perplexed.

Suddenly, I felt lighter. I was in a better form cruising through the light and wonderful fragrance. An experience par-excellence, I suddenly stopped and my son said "Your promised, uncle would look after us but no one is". I got agitated and prayed for a delay. Then I do not know what happened. The next, I heard was a female voice who said, "Take water". For a moment I thought, it could not be in 'hell'. A lady with water! "Where am I", I asked, "You are in the hospital sir, take the tablets", she said. "Oh yes". I took it only to vomit it straight into her hands. She stood the ground and did not even budge. No complaints ---- very business - like, Allah bless her. I did not know who she was. When I woke up it was dark out side and a doctor with a team of medical staff was around me. "It was a life after life..."





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
